SAINT JOSEPH'S & THE ANNUNCIATION

Ash Wednesday is this Wednesday and marks the beginning of Lent. Although it is not a holy day of obligation, there will be Masses at 10:00am at Stonehouse; and 12:00 noon at Woodchester. There will also be Masses at the Immaculate Conception, Stroud at 10:00am and 7:00pm. The blessing and distribution of ashes, which come from burnt palm branches, will take place during these Masses. This is a day of fast and abstinence. The law of abstinence binds those who have completed their 14th year and flesh meat is forbidden. The law of fasting binds those between 18 and 59 years of age (unless a medical condition prevents this), when one main meal and collations are allowed. Also do please remember that since September 2011 every Friday which is not a solemnity is a day of abstinence.

Stations of the Cross: There will be Stations of the Cross each Friday of Lent at 7:00pm at Saint Joseph's, Stonehouse. There will be a **Children's Stations of the Cross** at 6:00pm each Wednesday during Lent (beginning on 12th March) at the Immaculate Conception, Stroud.

First Holy Communion: Our First Holy Communion programme began this week. Our First Holy Communion children will show their commitment to this time of preparation during the Masses this Sunday. The next children's session will be on Saturday 15^{th} March (2:00pm – 4:30pm) at the Immaculate Conception, Stroud.

Grandparents Group meets every 1st Wednesday of the month at the Immaculate Conception, Stroud at 2:00pm (Coffee/tea and biscuits from 1:30pm). Everyone is welcome to this group for the exchange of experience, prayers and readings. Next meeting this Wednesday 5th March.

Rite of Election takes place at Clifton Cathedral next Saturday 8th March at 11:00am. We are invited to gather with adults seeking baptism or reception into the Church at Easter from across our diocese, including one from our parishes, for this important step in their journey of faith. We pray for all those in our parish and beyond who are discerning and journeying towards baptism or reception.

Year of Hope Reflections: There will be two sessions in our parishes giving us the opportunity to reflect on some readings for this Holy Year and to discuss what the Year of Hope means to us in our daily lives. The sessions are in the parish halls at 2:00pm (refreshments from 1:45pm) on Wednesday 12th March in Saint Joseph's, Stonehouse, and on Thursday 3rd April at the Immaculate Conception, Stroud. The sessions will finish around 3:00pm. All are welcome to one or both sessions.

Lenten Reconciliation Service: Bishop Bosco will be with us on Thursday 13th March at 7:00pm for a Lenten Reconciliation Service for our pastoral area at the Immaculate Conception, Stroud. Please consider coming for this celebration of God's mercy and forgiveness with the opportunity to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation (confession) with one of the priests present. There will be refreshments in the parish hall afterwards.

Cafod Lent Fast Day is on Friday 14th March and there will be a soup lunch at the Immaculate Conception, Stroud (12:00 noon – 1:00pm) on that day.
